Local Planning Scheme No.3 changes the zoning, land use permissions, density codes and development standards for the City of Nedlands. To assist the community in understanding the new requirements, the City will be holding the following information sessions throughout May:

### Footpaths and laneway obstructions

Residents are responsible for ensuring vegetation located on private property, or any plants on their verge (other than street trees) does not grow to cause obstruction to a footpath or laneway.

Where the City observes plants or trees are causing obstruction, the resident will receive notice to prune the vegetation away from the footpath or laneway. Failure to remove the obstructing vegetation may lead to the City issuing an infringement.
