The past month has been very exciting for the City of Nedlands, and I'm continually impressed with the enthusiasm of our community members.

It was a joy to talk with so many of you at the Mt Claremont Farmer's Markets regarding the FOGO rollout. The FOGO system will help to reduce our landfill by 65%, creating a better future for our children.

Speaking of children, I had the absolute pleasure of planting four Purple Beech trees in Mason Gardens with students from several local primary schools under a grant from Her late Majesty Queen Elizabeth II. As part of the planting ceremony, we unveiled a plaque commemorating her Platinum Jubilee.

Increasing and maintaining the tree canopy is a key goal for the City and there is currently an amendment open for public comment on the Your Voice platform. Scheme Amendment 12 will bring us in line with other states and cities around the world where you will need a Development Application to remove a tree on zoned blocks up to R20. I'm meeting with the West Australian Planning Commission to advocate for this amendment, and I encourage you to visit yourvoice.nedlands.wa.gov.au to have your say by the 11th of December.

In sports news, I recently met with Sailing Australia, WAIS, and the Nedlands Yacht Club, to facilitate an Olympic pathway training program at the yacht club. This is an opportunity for sailors to stretch their skills and increase their opportunities.

#### **FOGO is HERE!**

The City launched FOGO on the 7th of November 2023, 2 years ahead of the State Government's revised Waste Strategy which requires all Councils to move to the FOGO system by 2025. The most significant change to your waste service is that your red lid bin will be collected fortnightly not weekly. For more information head to nedlands.wa.gov.au/FOGO



#### **Waratah Avenue Upgrade complete**

The Citygreen upgrade to Dalkeith's central business hub has been completed. Over 15 trees were planted along the length of Waratah Avenue using the 'Stratavault' Structural Soil Vault system. This structural cell system enables plants to thrive in roadways when they would otherwise fail without disrupting infrastructure. This is the first time the system has been used within the City of Nedlands.
