Swanbourne Oval Greenway gets Coastwest Grant

The City of Nedlands, in partnership with Friends of Allen Park, Swanbourne Coastal Alliance and WA Planning Commission's Coastwest Grants Program, is increasing the ecological integrity of the coastal bushland corridor north and south to Cambridge and and Cottesloe.

Weed control is commencing in preparation for 4,500 local provenance species being planted. This project will help increase habitat and improve ecological corridors.
