As a true local with a proud family history of involvement in our community, I've worked tirelessly to protect Dalkeith Ward with a perfect attendance at meetings and participation on numerous committees over the past four years.

I'm proud of how much has been achieved in transformative organisational reform, while rate rises were kept low. A new enterprise resource system now safeguards the City and protects our valuable data. The drafting of missing strategic documents to provide direction and an asset management plan for the concerning maintenance backlog.

As Development Assessment Panel Member, I've been influential against inappropriate developments, empowering local communities, while lobbying for planning policies and amendments to curtail excessive density permitted under the imposed Local Planning Scheme 3.

On the Mains Roads Regional Group, I've sought grant funding to resurface roads, upgrade drainage, and fix accident black spots through access roads with the Waratah Avenue upgrade delivered and major projects scheduled for Broadway and the Avenue.

As Foreshore Management Plan Steering Committee Chair, I've initiated an eco-friendly plan for the river shoreline to protect our reserves as valued recreational space and wildlife habitat, while also providing leadership in the retention of tree canopy and heritage.
