There are two separate Library Bus routes that run on alternating Monday mornings. Clients are collected from their home or a designated location and driven to the library by our volunteers where they can select library items and enjoy morning tea together.

The Books on Wheels Service

The Books on Wheels Service was started in the 1970s and enables housebound Nedlands residents to have continual access to library materials.

This free service is based at Nedlands Library, organised by the Books on Wheels Officer and relies on the valued contribution of our wonderful volunteers.

Library items are selected and delivered by a team of dedicated volunteers who provide a meeting point between the library and housebound clients. Without them such an extensive undertaking would not be possible.

How the service works

What the library will do for you:

- Provide you with a selection of library items according to your reading preferences. This will be discussed at the initial interview with the Books on Wheels Officer.
- Deliver up to 12 items each fortnight. These items can include regular and large print books, audiobooks in CD, MP3, and Playaway formats, DVDs, magazines and music CDs.
- Deliver your library items in a library bag with an identifying tag.
- Include you on our library mailing list if desired. This mailing list notifies you of any upcoming library programs, events and newsletters as they become available.



What we ask you to do for us:

- Take responsibility for your library items. Keep them in the library bag provided so that they are easy to identify and to find.
- Return your books in the library bag to the volunteer each fortnight. If you are not home, place them in a secure and covered location for the volunteers to collect on your delivery day. Volunteers will not leave a new delivery without picking up the previous fortnight's items.
- Notify us of any changes that may affect the service, such as illness or vacation, so we can temporarily suspend delivery if necessary.
- Speak with the volunteers or the Books on Wheels Officer about items you would like to keep a little longer or any other requests you may have.
