Allen Park Precinct Signage

In response to the new *Dog Local Law 2023*, the City will be installing additional signage around the Allen Park Precinct in the coming months.

These signs will identify designated dog exercise areas where **dogs can be off lead** and areas where **dogs must be on lead**, particularly in the conservation areas.

There has been an increase in dogs being off lead in the Allen Park Bushland, which has raised concerns about the impact on local wildlife and the safety of dogs.

you know that using your woodfire heater properly not only keeps you warm but also

minimises smoke emissions into the air? Make the most of your woodfire heater

Start right: Begin your fire with dry kindling and the air intake fully open for a clean start.

Use dry, seasoned wood only: Wet or green

wood creates more smoke and pollutants.

Ensure proper ventilation: Make sure you operate your wood heater with the air intake
