Greetings Residents,

I am happy to say your feedback has been heard loud and clear this month and Council has made sound decisions which are in the best interests of our local community.

At the Ordinary Council Meeting on 24 September 2024, Council resolved not to proceed with the proposed heritage areas and related Local Planning Policy. This decision followed extensive community consultation, which showed the majority of those consulted were not supportive of the heritage areas proposal.

At this same meeting, Council resolved to proceed with The Avenue Safety Improvement Project which involves construction of a roundabout and raised treatments on The Avenue, Dalkeith. This project is fully funded by Main Roads WA and will minimise accidents on our throughfares to create a safer community for us all.

In other news, I extend a very special congratulations to our Ranger Team for being awarded Ranger Team of the Year 2024 by the WA Rangers Association. Our local Rangers are an incredible example of excellence at the City of Nedlands and its fantastic to see their hard work being recognised.
